## **General Information**

Here is some general information regarding the Feast of Tabernacles. Topics cover Registration, Service Times, Counseling, Anointing, Parking, Blessing of Little Children and Lost and Found. Please contact those serving at the Information Table for specific questions or needs.

#### **REGISTRATION**

Please register your attendance at the registration table as soon as possible. This helps in the preparation and planning of events both for this Feast and in the future.

#### SERVICE TIMES

Church services are held each day during the Feast and will commence at 10:30 am, except for the Last Great Day when services will commence at 11:00 am.

#### MINISTERIAL NEEDS

There will be a minister on-duty and on-call throughout the Feast for counseling, anointing, baptism counselling and baptism or any other need that may arise and require personal attention of the ministry.

#### PARKING

This year the State Parks Department will charge parking fees for the use of the parking lot next to the Convention Center. When you arrive at the parking lot notify the parking attendant that you are attending the Church Convention and tell the attendant you will go inside to get your parking pass. **Make sure you get it from one of our ushers and place it on your dash immediately.** The State will write you a ticket if the pass is not visible on the dash. YOU WILL NOT BE REQUIRED TO PAY FOR PARKING.

*However*, if you lose your original pass, the replacement will be a \$30.00 fee. The parking permit is valid for only eight days. With your parking permit you will have in and out parking privileges for the entire 8 days. See the usher or personnel at the Information Table for assistance. Thank you in advance for you cooperation.



#### **BLESSING OF LITTLE CHILDREN**

The Blessing of Little Children, as traditionally practiced by the Intercontinental Church of God, will take place during services on the Last Great Day. This service is usually for infants or smaller children that can be held in their parent's arms as the ministry lays hands on their heads and prays for God's Blessing for them individually. 
#### LOST & FOUND

Enjoy a rousing evening of BINGO and fun!! Numerous games will be played giving you plenty of chances to yell, "BINGO!" Great prizes to choose from!


### Health & Wellness Lunch-n-Learn Monday, October 2, 2023 1:30 pm - 3:00 pm


