- 2) NOTE: Donation drop off **DEADLINE will be 3pm** on the day of the raffle! You can see a volunteer at the doors to Majestic 2 if you're making a donation before 3pm.
- 3) So that we can ensure a timely setup for the doors to open at 5pm please abide by these guidelines – **PLEASE no late drop offs**.
- 4) We appreciate your assistance keeping these time guidelines....otherwise the doors cannot open on time. And we would hate to have to announce the person responsible for this delay. Just kidding, but please no late drop offs this year!

When the doors open at 5pm, you'll have the opportunity to find your seat, purchase raffle tickets, write your name on the tickets and drop them into the bags. The suspense will unfold as we kick off ticket drawings and begin announcing winners at 7pm. Volunteer Opportunities:

Load In/Set up - Wednesday – Oct. 16 - 9am-4pm – Convention area

If you're planning to arrive to the Feast early we could use your help with setting up our meeting space. Decorating the room, arranging the florals, setting up equipment, and setting up the registration area are a few areas where your assistance is needed.

Daily Door Greeters

Welcome guest as they enter the meeting room. All you need to do is choose a day and show up early.

Raffle

There are several volunteer opportunities for the raffle. Rebecca McCammon will explain all the specifics at our raffle volunteer meeting which will be announced during the Feast. Parents of the runners will also need to attend this brief meeting.

*Runners – children 5 and older are needed to “run” prizes to the winners. We plan to rotate the runners in 30-45 minute increments because the kiddos get tired after a little while. The rotation will begin when the raffle starts at 7pm

*Lead Runners – Two teens/young adults are needed to act as the “director” for the runners. Needed for the duration of the raffle beginning at 7pm

*Set up – We could use about 6 adults or older teens/young adults (no children please) to help with numbering and setting out all the prizes and bags. Set up is from 2pm – 5pm.

*Selling Tickets night of event – We need 2 - 4 adults to sell tickets at the registration table on the night of the raffle. These volunteers will rotate selling so that they all have the opportunity to drop their tickets. Ticket sells will start around 4:45pm and end around 6:45pm.
