There will be snacks and drinks available for purchase on board, but no meal is provided and you cannot bring your own food or drinks. There is a food truck (Papa Joe's), a coffee truck (Java Joe's) and a "bar" truck (Tequila Joe's) located near the dock, but please note that food is cooked to order so preparation may take up to 15-20 minutes. The boat will depart promptly at 2:00 PM and cannot wait. If you plan to get food/drinks from the trucks, arrive early enough to place your order. The only food allowed on board is what is purchased at the food trucks. No other outside food/drink will be allowed.

Here are some volunteer opportunities where you can lend a hand and make a difference!

*Set Up Day- Monday – Oct 6 - 9am-4pm – Convention area

If you're planning to arrive to the Feast early we could use your help with setting up our meeting space. Decorating the room, arranging the florals, setting up equipment, and setting up the registration area are a few areas where your assistance is needed.

*Daily Door Greeters

Welcome guest as they enter the meeting room. All you need to do is choose a day and show up early.

*Raffle
